**Sweet Potato Souffle**

**Sweet Potato Mixture:**

- 3 cups cooked mashed sweet potatoes
- 1c sugar
- 2 eggs well beaten
- ¾ stick of butter
- ½ c milk
- 1 tsp vanilla
- ½ tsp nutmeg
- ½ tsp cinnamon
- ½ c drained crushed pineapple

Mix above and put into a greased pan.

**Topping:**

- 1 c packed brown sugar
- 1/3 c flour
- 1 c chopped nuts
- ½ stick of butter

Mix and spread over sweet potatoes.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.

Especially good if the sweet potato mixture (except for sweet potatoes and butter) is made up ahead of time and refrigerated overnight.
