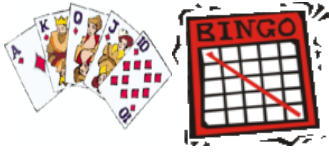


Whispering Pines

To All Home Owners

The dumpsters located at RV East & RV West are for RV residents only. RV residents do not have individual garbage cans on their lots.

If you are a manufactured home owner and have large items that will not fit into your individual garbage can, please call 321- 383 – 5755 to schedule a *free pick-up*. This way, WP will not incur any additional fees. Place your items conveniently at the end of your driveway of your own lot.

Unfortunately, WP has had to call for a total of four additional dumpster pick-ups above the regularly scheduled pick-ups. There is a stiff fee charged to WP for adding these extra pick-ups. Also, they will not pick up any items that are placed next to the dumpsters.

These extra costs are totally unnecessary, and are expensive for WP, and for all of us.

Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

The office will be closed all day on December 30th. It will be open only from 1-3 pm on December 23rd and 26th.
